- Family Well-Being: Parents & Families are safe, healthy, and have increased financial security.
- Positive Parent/Child Relationships: Beginning with transitions to parenthood, parents and families develop warm relationships that nurture their child's learning and development.
- Families as Lifelong Educators: Parents/Families are strong advocates and participants in the everyday learning of their children.
- Families as Learners: Families and parents observe, guide, promote and participate in the everyday learning of their children at home, school and in their communities.
- Family Engagement in Transitions: Parents and families support and advocate for their child's learning and development as they transition to new learning environments, including EHS to HS, EHS/HS to other learning environments, and HS to Kindergarten through elementary school.
- Family Connections to Peers & Community: Parents and families form connections with peers and mentors in formal or informal social networks that are supportive, educational, and enhance social well-being and community life.
- Families as Advocates and Leaders: Parents become leaders/advocates in the community and organize activities that lead to improved child development and learning experiences.
